Lend a Hand For The Development of Africa is a Non-Profit Organization centered around improving the quality of lives of low-income children and families amongst many others through the scholarship scheme, access to basic health care, food supplies and sensitization programs. Over the years, we have stayed committed in ensuring that the underserved communities gets equal chance to quality education, basic health care and more.

The organization was given access to greater and better possibilities to accomplish more for the communities we have been called to serve during this year, which was truly an eventful one. We owe every milestone crossed to God, who has committed this assignment to our hands and also provided the people, partnerships, funds, and other resources to cater efficiently and effectively. It was a great run with a remarkable ending. The resources from donors and partners cannot be denied and this was a major factor in the success of all projects carried out this year.

The projects are:

- Monthly food drive We supported children, women and families with food supplies in 3 communities in Lagos. In December, we included Niger State.
- Scholarship Scheme We continued with the existing beneficiaries and added 3 new children to the scheme. Much more, a few of our beneficiaries transitioned from a level of education to another.
- Reading Club There was a partnership with Ingressive For Good to foster the reading culture in Lahakids and ensure exposure to realities beyond their present environment.
- Skill Acquisition Two girls were sponsored to a skill acquisition training to learn Tailoring and the art of Makeup/Gele respectively. We continued with our boy child in the football academy.

Partnerships and Awards:

- ~ Applatch: this partnership was directed to the Scholarship Scheme and we were able to get 2 children on board in the community of Agege.
- ~ Ingressive For Good: Hero books was sent to the organization.
- ~ Lagos Food Bank: Just as the name implies, we partnered with the organization to get food supplies to more families across communities.
- ~ Peak: With what started as the organization coming 3rd in Peak Unstoppable Human of Change. We also received trays of peak milk and it was distributed during the Christmas food drive.
- ~ Eloy Awards: Abimbola Ajala was nominated under the Award For Humanitarian NGO category. We didn't win but we are grateful for the platform and opportunity.
- ~ FemConnect: There was a dialogue on Menstrual Health to discuss issues surrounding it and how period poverty can be allevated.
